In Rabat (Victoria, Gozo) is a set of 5 chiming bells cast by Taylor in 2004, the heaviest weighing 89-1-14 in G (10010 lbs), and all forming a chord in G.

MOSKVA (Moscow), Russia

On a pedestal near the base of the Ivan Veliki (Ivan the Great) belltower in the Kremlin is "Tsar Kolokol" (Emperor Bell) of 210 tons (198000 kg), cast by Motorin in 1733. It is the largest bell ever cast in the world, but was broken in a great fire before being hung or rung. (Also reported as having been rung once only, after being hoisted out of its in-ground mold.)

The broken piece weighs 11000 kg.

Also near here are three other great bells, of 72000 kg (1817), 56000 kg and 33000 kg (both 1819), as well as the "Trotzkoi", 164000 kg.
