BALTIMORE - CC USA - MD
 Christ Church (Episcopal), first bldg.
 A ring of 6 bells was cast by Thomas
 Mears of London (Whitechapel) in 1804,
 and hung in the new steeple of Christ
 Church in 1805. In the War of 1812,
 they were taken down for safety and
 hidden. After the war, only three
 were recovered from the hiding place,
 and were rehung. In 1835/6 they were
 moved to a new building, CC's second.
 In 1871, the congregation again moved,
 with at least one bell; the old bldg.
 was renamed Church of the Messiah.
 In 1904, the Church of the Messiah was
 destroyed by fire, but some metal was
 recovered from the bell which hung
 there at the time. In 1908, Christ
 Church bought a chime of 13 bells from
 the McShane foundry; at that time the
 remaining Mears bells were returned to
 the Church of the Messiah. In 1920,
 the Messiah congregation moved to its
 present location on Harford Road; in
 1922, a Mears bell plus bell metal
 recovered from the 1904 fire plus a
 bell formerly in St. Andrew's Chapel
 on Harford Road were cast into a new
 bell by McShane. It is not clear what
 happened to the other two recovered
 Mears bells.
 The McShane chime in the third bldg.
 of Christ Church is under 'Chimes'.
